ST. DAVID'S CANDIDATE FOR THE DIACONATE! BARB WEZA!

We are officially on the path to Phase II of discernment to the diaconate process! Thank you for your encouragement, affirmations, and spiritual guidance! I am so grateful and excited.

We have met with Rev. Gen Grewell and a member of the Commission on Ministry to make my intentions to discern the diaconate official. Phase I has been completed by having my call confirmed by another discernment team, our priest, members of the congregation and community. Phase II is approximately 9 months of meeting with a second discernment team including Fr. Joe, 2 vestry members (Patti Case and Laurie McClanahan), and a member of the community at large who knows me outside of the church to study, pray, and discern deeper into focused areas of my life, faith, and ministry. During this time I will also be attending Deacon retreats and activities and continuing to meet with a spiritual advisor. In October, if the team mutually discerns my call I would be eligible to apply for BACUM, (a focused weekend in December of interviews and activities with the Bishop's advisory committee) to judge whether or not I am fit to become a postulant for candidacy. I will continue to share the journey with all of you, my family at St. David's and thank you for your patience and support.
