We hope this exercise will also help us see what we as individuals, and we as a parish, can do to deepen our faith. We'll map out our parish and our individual priorities according to the

Join us this Thursdays at 5:30 pm for our Evening Prayer service and then partake of a delicious bowl of soup and some bread and more as we get ready for this second exercise - while all the time having in our view the history time-line in our fellowship area. You are so critical to this unfolding and so please plan on joining this coming Thursday and then again on Sunday at 9 am.
