 Lent.

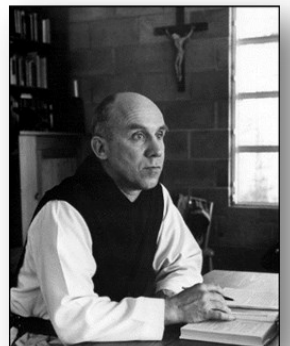
